



Infrastructure

The school has an impressive and well-designed building with naturally well-lit corridors and spacious classrooms. To make the teaching learning process more effective, Interactive pannel through "SENSES BOARD" has been introduced.

Effective Surveillance system

130 CCTV cameras have been installed in the school campus to keep a check on all the happenings and the conduct of the students to maintain discipline. The school security cameras work throughout the school hours to ensure the safety of our students and keep all untoward instance at bay. The school has installed a generator set of 62.5 KW to provide uninterrupted power supply during the school hours. This efficient power back up facility further ensures the smooth functioning of activities at all times.

Bus Services

The school buses follow a fixed route and stop only at the established centres, where the students of the neighbourhood should gather.

GPS Bus Tracking System

All buses are equipped with GPS tracking system to govern speed and to ensure security.

Well Maintained Laboratories

- Computer Lab-Has internet facility, enabling students to access global network.
- Social Science Lab-Students make models and structures that form a part of their curriculum. This paves the way for valuable participation and contribution to the School Exhibition by our creative masterminds.

Library



Auditorium

With due importance given to the co-curricular activities in the school, we have a school auditorium with a capacity of 800 students. It helps us in organizing various cultural events and bringing forth the talent of the Francisians.

Faculty

In pursuit of excellence the school engages men and women of high professional competence, moral integrity and dedication to guide the students. Counsellor

School has engaged a professional counsellor for guiding the students, especially those who need special care, guidance and understanding. Parents may be permitted to take help from the counsellor with the permission of the school management.

To maintain a balance between the key scholastic and co-scholastic areas various clubs have been formed. This ensures the enhancement of various skills, thereby making the students great planners, organizers and performers.

Cultural Club

Students gain experience and get an exposure to planning and organizing various events. The club functions as the Event Manager of the school.

Eco Club

Eco-friendliness and ecology form and integral part of the School's curriculum. Through talks, film shows, exhibitions, and experiments, they are repetitively brought home to all those associated with the school. No wonder, children plant more and more trees and delightfully nurture them too. Franciscans are taught to say no to poly bags and refrain from wasting Paper.

Literary Club

The young writers and poets get opportunities to showcase their creative skills. The club members are actively involved in designing the annual school magazine.

Art Club
